IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR CAT OWNERS

The *Cat Act 2011* requires the identification, registration and sterilisation of domestic cats, and gives local governments the power to administer and enforce the legislation.

The legislation takes full effect from 1 November 2013 and provides for better management of the unwanted impacts of cats on the community and the environment, as well as encourage responsible cat ownership.

From **1 November 2012**, some provisions of the Act commenced to allow local governments to prepare to administer and enforce the legislation.

From **1 November 2013**, the full *Cat Act 2011* takes effect and will require all cats that have reached 6 months of age to be:

Micro-chipped, Sterilised and Registered with the relevant local government.

Cats will be required to wear a collar and registration tag to ensure that owned cats can be easily identified and returned to their owner.

In addition to the cats registration tag being attached to a collar, the owner's details and contact number must also be attached to the collar. It is recommended that the name of the cat is engraved on this attached tag.

PLEASE NOTE

1. Definition of a **PENSIONER** is as follows;
A person issued with a Pensioner Concession Card.
2. **PLEASE advise the Shire if your circumstances change in anyway i.e. address, Contact Details, ownership, or Cat/s passing away / euthanaised.** (This will alleviate any unnecessary grief to you or your family at renewal time by receiving a notice for your beloved pet no longer here).
3. The person who is named on the front of this form, and signs this declaration is responsible for the cat and must be over 18 years of age.
4. Cat owners are also reminded that Cats aged six (6) months and over must be registered at all times. A cat, which has been seized and impounded for wandering, will not be released until all associated fees are paid and the cat is registered or proof of registration is provided.
