**A current Pensioner Concession card or a copy of either a Centrelink or Department of Veteran Affairs 'Commonwealth Seniors Health Card' together with a Seniors Card must be produced to claim concession.

IMPORTANT INFORMATION FOR DOG OWNERS

NUISANCE BARKING

If you own a dog, you are responsible for ensuring it does not create a public nuisance by barking excessively. Nuisance barking also covers public places adjoining your property.

DOG ATTACKS

A dog does NOT have to bite a person or animal for the Local Government to consider it to be an attack under State Legislation.

If a dog attacks or chases any person, or any animal owned or in the charge of another person, whether or not any injury is caused, every person liable for the control of the dog commits an offence.

MICROCHIPPING

- From 01 November 2013, dogs must be microchipped when they are registered for the first time or when a change of ownership occurs.
- By 30 November 2013 all dangerous dogs, which includes restricted breeds, and commercial security dogs, must be microchipped.
- By 01 November 2015, all dogs must be microchipped.

KEEPING MORE THAN TWO DOGS

Households can apply for permission to keep more than two dogs by completing the **keeping more than two dog's application form**.

A fee of \$50.00 applies to the application. The fee is non-refundable should the application be declined.

IMPOUNDING

A dog, which has been seized and impounded for wandering, will not be released until all associated fees are paid and the dog is registered, or proof of registration is provided.

PLEASE NOTE:

- The Definition of a **WORKING DOG** for concessional registration purposes is as follows:
*Dog used for the droving or caring of stock. **
- Definition of a **PENSIONER** for concessional registration purposes is as follows: **
 - a) a person issued with a Pensioner Concession Card, including a Disability Pension; or
 - b) a person issued with a Seniors Card AND Commonwealth Seniors Health Card.
- Maximum number of dogs (over the age of 3 months) to be kept on any premises is two (2). Dispensation can be given to keep more than 2 dogs on rural properties.

To register a dog under sterilised concessional rates, an owner or agent should either have a veterinarian's certificate or be prepared to sign a statutory declaration to that effect.

Dog owners are also reminded that dogs 3 months and over must always be registered. Council also requests that dog owners inform Council immediately of any change of ownership, the death of a dog, or change of address.

Failure to register a dog may result in a penalty under the Dog Act 1976.

The person who is named on the front of this form and signs this declaration is responsible for the dog and must be over 18 years of age.
