How will members access an RBdigital magazine through the library?

Members can access the service via a link on their library's website, taking them to the RBdigital landing page of the Western Australian Public Library Digital Media Collection site.

1. Click on the RB Digital Magazines link
2. Login OR select 'create account'.
3. Select 'Shire of Dandaragan Libraries' from the dropdown list.
4. Browse magazines using the Search (magnifying glass icon), or Filter by Genre.
5. Select a magazine & click on Checkout. Either select 'start reading' OR 'keep browsing'
6. To view magazines that you have checked out – click on My Collection. To keep browsing, click on 'return to magazine collection'.

Using the App

1. Install the app on your device. Available via the Apple App Store or Google Play Store.
2. Choose your library from the list.
3. Browse magazines using the Search (magnifying glass icon), OR Filter by Genre.
4. Select a magazine & click on Checkout.
5. Download your magazine to read when you are offline or select Read.

FAQs

What titles will be available?	A wide range of popular current magazines comprising Australian and international content.
Will new titles be added?	New titles will be added over time. It is also worth noting that some current titles may be discontinued by their publishers or the RBdigital service based on usage or currency of information.
How many items can members borrow?	Members can borrow as many issues as they want and keep them in their account as long as they wish.
Can RBdigital titles be renewed?	There is no need to renew titles as members can keep titles for as long as they wish.
Can members return eMagazines early?	RBdigital eMagazines never need to be returned; they stay on loan as long as needed.
Can RBdigital titles be reserved?	There is no need to reserve a title; RBdigital has no limits for a member and no returns are necessary.
Can eMagazines be downloaded directly onto a mobile device?	Not directly - members will need to install the RBdigital mobile app to read their titles.
What other help is available online?	RBdigital has an online Help section through the WAPLDMC site: https://www.rbdigital.com/wapldmc/help .
Can members download eMagazines in the library?	Members with a laptop, tablet etc may be able to connect to the library WIFI (if available) and download eMagazines.
Why can't I find the titles I want?	If you have no luck with the standard 'Title Search' (which also has a drop-down menu listing every magazine alphabetically), try going through the Genre drop-down menu on the righthand side. If you still cannot find the title, it may not be provided by the service.
