

# 2025 / 2026 Annual Budget Major Income & Expenses

#### **Rates Revenue**

\$8.3 million



- A 4% rate increase for 2025/26 has been imposed to yield the deficiency in the budget.
- The GRV rate in the dollar has increased from \$0.0761 to \$0.0791 and the UV rate in the dollar has decreased from \$0.0043 to \$0.0037.
