WEEKLY RECYCLING OVER SUMMER PERIOD JURIEN BAY TOWNSITE

During the summer Xmas and New Year Holidays of 2016 / 17 the Shire of Dandaragan will be again trialling a weekly Recycling Waste Collection Service throughout the Jurien Bay town site, in addition to the normal fortnightly service. This will run from the week beginning Monday 19 December 2016 through to and inclusive of Tuesday 31 January 2017. Normal services will resume as of Monday 6 February 2017. The proposed Recycling Waste Collection schedule will be as follows:

If the demand for these additional services is such, the Shire will investigate the merit of continuing the additional weekly recycling collection services within Jurien Bay and potentially across other parts of the Shire over the busy tourist periods of Christmas, New Year and Easter on a permanent basis.

Should any commercial operators within Jurien Bay, potentially require an additional weekly normal waste collection service (ie bi-weekly with an additional service on a Friday) during this period, please directly contact the Shire's Executive Manager Infrastructure to discuss these potential additional services and subsequent commercial arrangements.
