Nominations must be lodged with the Returning Officer:

at any time during the above period by arrangement; or between 2:00pm and 4:00pm Thursday, 14 September 2017 (close of nominations) at the Shire of Dandaragan, Bashford Street, JURIEN BAY.

#### Nominations Requirements

Candidates are required to lodge with the Returning Officer:

a completed nomination in the prescribed form, signed and witnessed. (This form is available from the Returning Officer, the Western Australian Electoral Commission or the Shire of Dandaragan);

a single A4 page profile containing not more than 150 words of information about the candidate;

a nomination deposit of \$80 (cash, bank cheque or postal order); and

a recent passport-sized photograph (optional).

The Commission has developed an online system called Nomination Builder to assist candidates to complete their nomination form which includes the candidate profile. This is the preferred method of completing the nomination form and profile for elections conducted by the Commission. Candidates complete their nomination details and profile, print the completed form which has a reference number allocated and lodge it with the Returning Officer. The nomination builder can be accessed at [elections.wa.gov.au](http://elections.wa.gov.au)

Where an agent lodges a nomination on a candidate's behalf, it must be in the prescribed form with a written authorisation signed by the candidate.

The documents may be hand delivered, posted or faxed to the Returning Officer and must be received by the close of nominations.

### RESPONSE TO FOUR CORNERS INVESTIGATION INTO WASTE MANAGEMENT

"A recent ABC Four Corners programme investigated waste management practices in NSW and QLD. The Shire was contacted by Southern Metropolitan Regional Council (SMRC) who would like to reemphasize that recyclables collected in the yellow-topped bins processed by the SMRC are recovered to the fullest extent possible with 85% of recyclables recovered and made into new products.

This includes glass which is recovered, ground and used in road base, as well as plastics, paper, cardboard, steel and aluminum which command a high value when sold to domestic and international markets.

The organic fraction of the green-topped general waste bins processed by the SMRC is recovered and processed into compost which is used in agriculture.

The SMRC is a transparent, local government organisation, committed to working with its member councils and the community to ensure environmentally sustainable outcomes.

The SMRC plays an important role in working towards increased recycling rates and encourages the community to assist our efforts by ensuring they continue to put the right thing in the right bin.

Residents of member Councils and members of the public can attend free tours of the Regional Resource Recovery Centre (RRRC) in Canning Vale to see firsthand what happens to their waste and virtual tours are also available on the Recycle Right website [www.recycleright.wa.gov.au](http://www.recycleright.wa.gov.au)."

## NOTICE TO ALL OWNERS AND OR OCCUPIERS OF LAND WITHIN THE SHIRE OF DANDARAGAN RESTRICTED BURNING PERIOD

Please be advised, the Shire of Dandaragan will be entering into the **Restricted Burning Period**. as of 1 October 2017 and up to and including 30 October 2017, permits to burn **ARE REQUIRED**.

**A permit to burn must be obtained from your local Fire Control Officer during the restricted burning period.** Permits are subject to a number of conditions but will NOT be issued for burning on Sundays or public holidays, unless approved by the Chief Bush Fire Control Officer.

If you cannot make contact with your closest possible Fire Control Officer to arrange a permit, please call the Community Emergency Services Co-ordinator on 9652 0800 or 0428 114 221.

Please take all necessary precautions when burning, ensure you read and understand the conditions of the permit before commencing. The Shire of Dandaragan must be notified of all permit burning before commencing. Ensure you notify all your neighbours including the Department of Biodiversity Conservation and Attractions if your property adjoins their land.

If the fire danger forecast for the day issued by the **Bureau of Meteorology** is forecast for **VERY HIGH** or above, all permits are cancelled and the burn cannot be implemented.

## TRONOX AND SHIRE OF DANDARAGAN COMMUNITY SPORTING AND RECREATION FACILITIES FUND 2017 / 2018

The Tronox and Shire of Dandaragan Community Sporting and Recreation Facilities Fund provides grant funding to local clubs and community groups within the Shire for sporting and recreation equipment and small scale infrastructure projects each year.

A total of 26 applications were received. The amount of grant funding available for distribution this year was \$43,400.97.
