SHIRE OF DANDARAGAN LOCAL PLANNING SCHEME No.7 AMENDMENT No.36 – AVAILABLE FOR INSPECTION

Notice is hereby given that the Shire of Dandaragan has prepared the above mentioned planning scheme amendment to introduce special control areas for Public Drinking Water Source Areas and modify the wording of scheme provisions to allow for subdivision and development to occur within the existing Bassendean Precinct Special Control Area.

This amendment is a recommendation of the Shire's current and draft Local Planning Strategies. The scheme provisions of this amendment will allow for future subdivisions and development proposals within the two Special Control Areas; subject to comment from relevant government agencies and satisfaction from the decision maker that such proposals can be managed without adverse impacts on the vulnerable environmental attributes contained with the two Special Control Areas.

Documents setting out and explaining the scheme amendment are available for viewing at the Shire Administration Centre at 69 Bashford Street, Jurien Bay during normal opening hours or via the Shire's website at www.dandaragan.wa.gov.au. For further information on the documentation, please contact the Planning Department at the Shire Administration Centre on 9652 0800.

Submissions on the planning scheme amendment may be lodged in writing and should include the amendment number, the property affected and details of the submission and lodged with the undersigned on or before Friday 4th January 2019.

This amendment is available for inspection in order to provide an opportunity for public comment and it should not be construed that final approval will be granted.

EXPRESSIONS OF INTEREST – CHUBB SAFE

The Shire of Dandaragan is seeking Expressions of Interest from members of the local community who are interested in purchasing and removing a Chubb safe manufactured in the mid to late 1950's.

The safe's external dimensions are 660(H) x 560(W) x 430(D) and its internal dimensions are 500(H) x 420 (W) x 345 (D) with an adjustable internal shelf. The safe is of considerable weight ranging between 300kg to 350kg.

The safe also has two locking mechanisms; a key lock and a dial lock, however both require repairs. It is to be understood that arrangements for the safe's removal and relocation will also be the responsibility of the successful proponent

Interested parties can view the safe at the Shire of Dandaragan's Administration Centre at 69 Bashford Street, Jurien Bay from Wednesday, 28 November 2018 – Friday, 14 December 2018 during business hours. Photographs of the safe are also attached to this Expression of Interest.
